Term and Conditions

- This voucher will only be valid for parking after 9.30am in listed car parks on Saturday 4th July 2009. A map showing the location of these car parks can be viewed at www.guildford.gov.uk/parking
- The vehicle registration number and the correct time of arrival must be inserted or the voucher may be void.
- Only one voucher will be accepted per vehicle per day giving a maximum of 3 hours free parking on 4th July. Vehicles using more than one voucher to park are liable for a penalty charge.
- If you want to park for longer than 3 hours please purchase a pay and display ticket when you arrive and the 3 hours free parking will start from the expiry time on your ticket.
- This voucher is not valid in any disabled or contract parking space as these spaces can only be used by people who are eligible and display the relevant permit.
- Vehicles must be parked in marked bays and in accordance with the parking order (see tariff boards in car parks).
