BOROUGH OF GUILDFORD

BYELAWS

Made under Section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 by the Council of the Borough of Guildford

with respect to:

ROLLER SKATING AND SKATEBOARDING IN THE BOROUGH OF **GUILDFORD**

1. No person shall on any public carriageway, footway, pedestrian underpass or paved court to which the public have access skate on rollers, skateboards, wheels or other mechanical contrivances to the danger of other persons lawfully using the carriageway, footway, pedestrian underpass or paved court.
2. In these Byelaws the expression 'paved court' shall include in particular but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing phrase the areas listed in the Schedule hereto.
3. Any person offending against the foregoing Byelaws shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds.

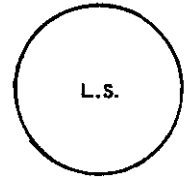
