We are delighted that Mary Branson, Guildford based installation artist and print maker, has agreed to be our Patron for this year's event. Mary is best known for her

large-scale light sculptures and installations, notably the iconic 'New Dawn' sculpture in the Houses of Parliament, which celebrates the centenary of the Suffrage movement. She's created light and sound works for the London 2012 Olympics, Runnymede's Magna Carta Memorial, Royal Holloway University and 'Harvest' - a huge site-specific installation at Box Hill, Surrey. Most recently she transformed Salisbury Cathedral into an ethereal construction site for Sky Arts. Mary's last artistic residency was for Watts Gallery, where her latest sculpture 'Daughters of Theia' is currently on show. 
