

**GUILDFORD ON-STREET PARKING MANAGEMENT REVIEW -
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE PARISHED AREAS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF GUILDFORD**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Surrey County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and 36 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') the effect of which will be to further amend "The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Parished Areas within the Borough of Guildford (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2004". The Order, to be known as "The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Parished Areas within the Borough of Guildford (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Amendment Order (No.X) 20XX" proposes to make the changes as described below.

The general purpose and effect of the Order will be to:

- (a) introduce new At Any Time and Monday to Friday 8.30am to 6pm waiting restrictions,
- (b) provide that in the lengths of roads referred to in paragraph (a) above that, in respect to waiting restrictions, the usual exemptions for loading and unloading vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, using vehicles for works on or adjoining those lengths of roads and the services in them and for disabled persons' vehicles in accordance with the "Blue Badge" Scheme would apply.

Elm Lane, Tongham (both sides from its junction with Manor Rd to 15m east)

Field Way, Tongham (both sides from its junction with Manor Rd to 10m east)

Georgelands, Ripley (both sides from its junction with Newark Ln to 15m south)

Guildford Road, Ash (south side from 17m west to 20m east of its junction with Harper's Rd)

Harper's Road, Ash (both sides from its junction with Guildford Rd to 15m south)

Kings Road, Shalford (southwest side from junction with Horsham Rd to 15m northwest of its junction with Kings Rd)

Lower Street, Shere (various lengths on both sides from its junction with Middle St to 15m west of its junction with Orchard Rd)

Manor Road, Tongham (various lengths both sides from 20m south of its junction with Spoil Ln to 20m north of its junction with Elm Ln)

Manor Close, Tongham (both sides from its junction with Manor Rd to 15m west)

Middle Street, Shere (various lengths on both sides from 18m north to 15m south of its junction with Lower St)

New Road, Chilworth (south side from 15m west to 15m east of its junction with Brookwood)

Newark Lane, Ripley (south side from 15m west to 45m east of its junction of Georgelands)

Oak Tree Close, Ash Vale (both side from its junction with Stratford Rd to 10m south)

Pathfields, Shere (both sides from its junction with Sandy Ln to 20m southwest)

Pincott Lane, West Horsley (both sides from its junction with The Street to 15m west)

Poyle Road, Tongham (south side from 60m to 93m east of its junction with The Street)

Sandy Lane, Shere (west side from its junction with Pathfields to 20m south)

School Lane, West Horsley (both sides from its junction with The Street to 15m east)

Shere Lane, Shere (various lengths on the west side from 20m north of its junction with Pilgrims Way to its junction with Pathfields)

Silkmore Lane, West Horsley (both sides from its junction with The Street to 30m northwest)

Spoil Lane, Tongham (various lengths on both sides from its junction with Manor Rd to 10m east of its junction with The Gardens)

Stratford Road, Ash Vale (various lengths on both sides from 20m east of its junction with Oak Tree Cl to 18m northeast of its junction with The Beeches)

The Elms, Tongham (both sides from its junction with Manor Rd to 15m east)

The Gardens, Tongham (both sides from its junction with Spoil Lane to 10m south)

The Street, Tongham (various lengths both sides from 7m south of its junction from Grange Rd to 20m south of the access to Manor House Flats)

The Street, West Horsley (various lengths on both sides from 20m south its junction with School Ln to 30m north of its junction with Silkmore Ln)

NO WAITING MONDAY–FRIDAY 8AM–6PM

Stratford Road (on the west side from 63m northeast of its roundabout junction with the B3166 to 23m south of its junction with Meadow Cl)
