

**GUILDFORD ON-STREET PARKING MANAGEMENT REVIEW -  
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE PARISHED AREAS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF GUILDFORD**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Surrey County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and 36 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') the purpose and effect of which is to further amend "The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Parished Areas within the Borough of Guildford (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2004". The Order, to be known as "The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Parished Areas within the Borough of Guildford (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Amendment Order (No. ) 202-" proposes to make the changes as described below.

The general purpose and effect of the Order is to:

- (a) introduce new No Waiting At Any Time waiting restrictions (double yellow lines),
- (b) introduce new No Waiting Monday – Friday 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. waiting restrictions (single yellow lines);
- (c) in respect to paragraphs (a) and (b) above, the usual exemptions for loading and unloading vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, using vehicles for works on or adjoining those lengths of roads and the services in them and for disabled persons' vehicles in accordance with the "Blue Badge" Scheme would apply,
- (d) introduce new permit only parking places for use only by residents of the properties Nos. 1 to 6 inclusive Manor Fields and with only one permit for one vehicle per property at a cost of £80 per annum,
- (e) formalise certain existing School Keep Clear markings so that they become subject to a No Stopping Monday-Friday 8-10am & 2.30-4.30pm restriction,
- (f) introduce a Monday-Saturday 8.30am-6pm 2-Hour Limited Waiting No Return Within 4 Hours Parking Place for use by passenger vehicles (8 seats or less), goods vehicles with a maximum gross weight not exceeding 5 tonnes, motorcycles and invalid carriages
- (g) introduce Monday-Saturday 8.30am-6pm 2-Hour Limited Waiting No Return Within 1 Hour Parking Places for use by passenger vehicles (8 seats or less), goods vehicles with a maximum gross weight not exceeding 5 tonnes, motorcycles and invalid carriages,
- (h) in respect to paragraphs (e) and (f) above, disabled persons' vehicles displaying a disabled person's blue badge may wait in those parking places free of charge and without time limit,
- (i) in respect to paragraphs (e) and (f) above, any vehicle may wait in those parking places for the purposes of boarding and alighting (for a period not exceeding two minutes), or for the purpose of loading or unloading goods (for a period not exceeding twenty minutes), and
- (j) in respect to paragraph (d) above, any vehicle may stop on those School Keep Clear markings in respect of certain emergency vehicles, for the purposes of delivering and collecting postal packets, vehicles which cannot proceed due to circumstances beyond the driver's control or to avoid injury or damage to persons or property, using vehicles for works on or adjoining the affected lengths of roads and the services in them and to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, a traffic warden or a traffic officer in uniform.

**INTRODUCE NO WAITING AT ANY TIME RESTRICTIONS (DOUBLE YELLOW LINES)**

**A324 Guildford Road/The Green, Pirbright** (*both sides from 40m north of its junction with Avenue De Cagny to 30m south thereof and from 30m north of its junction with D46/D47 The Green to 30m south thereof and on the west side from 20m north of its junction with the northern arm of D46 The Green to 20m south thereof*).

**Ash Hill Road, Ash** (*Various lengths, both sides, from 21m to 115m south-east of its junction with Shawfield Road*).

**Ash Green Lane West** (*Various lengths both sides from it's junction with Manor Road to 114m East*)

**Ash Street, Ash** (*Various lengths, north-west side, from 60m to 85m north-east of its junction with Star Lane*)

**Avenue de Cagny, Pirbright** (Various lengths, both sides, from its junction with A324 Guildford Road/The Green to its junction with D47 The Green at The Cricketers/White Hart Corner).

**D46 The Green, Pirbright** (Both sides of both arms, from their junctions with A324 Guildford Road/The Green to 15 metres either north and then north-west or south-west thereof).

**Colekitchen Lane, Gomshall** (Both sides from its junction with Station Road to 15m north-east thereof).

**Dorset Road, Ash Vale** (Both sides, from its junction with Prospect Road to 15m east thereof).

**West Ring, The Cardinals, Tongham** (Both sides, from its junction with North Side to 12 metres south thereof).

**Elleray Court, Ash Vale** (Both sides, from 10m to 15m east of its junction with Prospect Road).

**Elstead Road, Seale** (Both sides, from 50m north of its junction with Seale Lane to 30m south-east of its junction with Wood Lane)

**Gorselands Close, Ash Vale** (Both sides, from 10m to 15m east of its junction with Prospect Road).

**North Side, The Cardinals, Tongham** (On the south side from 15m north-east of its junction with West Ring to 15m south-west of its junction with West Ring).

**Oxenden Road, Ash** (Both sides, from 15m north to 15m south of its junction with Philips Close).

**Philips Close, Ash** (Both sides, from its junction with Oxenden Road to 15m west thereof).

**Prospect Road Ash Vale** (Various lengths, both sides, from 15m north of its junction with Dorset Road to 40m south of its junction with Enfield Road).

**Seale Lane, Seale** (Various lengths both sides, from its junction with Elstead Road to 270m west thereof).

**Springfield Road, Ash Vale** (Both sides, from its junction with Prospect Road to 15m west thereof).

**Station Road, Gomshall** (Both sides, from 23m east of its junction with Colekitchen Lane to 78m west thereof).

**Suffield Lane, Puttenham** (Both sides, from its junction with The Street to 10m south thereof).

**West Ring and South Side, The Cardinals, Tongham** (Various lengths on both sides, from 15m north of its junction with East Ring to 15m south of its junction with West Ring).

**The Street, Puttenham** (Both sides, from 10m west to 35m east of its junction with Suffield Lane).

**West Ring, The Cardinals, Tongham** (Both sides, from its junction with West Ring/South Side westwards for 20m).

**D47 The Green, Pirbright** (part of which is also known as "White Hart Corner") (Various lengths, both sides and north-west side, from its junction with A324 Guildford Road/The Green to its junction with Avenue de Cagny).

**D47 The Green, Pirbright** (both sides, from its junction with Avenue de Cagny to 75m north-east and east thereof).

**Wood Lane, Seale** (Both sides, from its junction with Elstead Road to 40m east thereof).

#### **INTRODUCE NO WAITING MONDAY-FRIDAY 8AM – 6PM (SINGLE YELLOW LINES)**

**East Ring, The Cardinals, Tongham**, (south side, from 15m to 65m east of its junction with West Ring)

**The Street, West Clandon** (both sides from the southern boundary of "The Post House" to the northern wall of "Little Clandon")

#### **CONVERT LIMITED WAITING 2 HOURS NO RETURN WITHIN 4 HOURS PARKING PLACE TO NO WAITING AT ANY TIME DOUBLE YELLOW LINES**

**Ash Street, Ash** (north-west side, from 67.5m to 85m north-east of its junction with Star Lane)

#### **INTRODUCE PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY PARKING PLACE MON – SAT 8.30AM – 6PM**

**Elstead Road** (East side from 55m – 13m North of it's junction with Wood Lane)

#### **INTRODUCE LIMITED WAITING 2 HOUR NO RETURN WITHIN 1 HOUR MON-SAT 8.30 AM-6PM PARKING PLACES**

**Ash Hill Road, Ash Vale** (south-west side, from 20m to 41m south-east of its junction with Shawfield Road)

**Shawfield Road, Ash Vale** (south-east side, from 15m to 60m south-west of its junction with Ash Hill Road)

**Vale Road, Ash Vale** (*north-east side, from 85m to 110m west of its junction with Wharf Road.*)

**FORMALISE NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS MONDAY-FRIDAY 8-10AM & 2.30-4.30PM**

**West Ring, The Cardinals, Tongham** (*formalise the existing markings on the east side outside Tongham Day Care and St Paul's Church of England Infant School from 18m to 40m south of its junction with East Ring.*)

**The Street, Clandon** (*formalise the existing markings on the west side outside Clandon Church of England Aided Infant School from the northern boundary of the "Bulls Head" PH to the northern boundary of Clandon Primary School*)
