

**GUILDFORD ON-STREET PARKING MANAGEMENT REVIEW -
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE GUILDFORD TOWN AREA OUTSIDE OF THE GUILDFORD
TOWN CENTRE CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Surrey County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and 36 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') the effect of which will be to further amend "The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Guildford (Guildford Town Area Outside of the Guildford Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions Street Parking Places and Revocation) Order 2004". The Order, to be known as "The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Guildford (Guildford Town Area Outside of the Guildford Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions Street Parking Places and Revocation) Amendment Order (No.-) 202-" proposes to make the changes as described below.

The general purpose and effect of the Order will be to:

- (a) introduce new At Any Time waiting restrictions,
- (b) introduce new No Waiting Mon-Friday 8am – 6pm restrictions,
- (c) provide that in the lengths of roads referred to in paragraph (a) above that, in respect to waiting restrictions, the usual exemptions for loading and unloading vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, using vehicles for works on or adjoining those lengths of roads and the services in them and for disabled persons' vehicles in accordance with the "Blue Badge" Scheme would apply.

INTRODUCE NO WAITING AT ANY TIME DOUBLE YELLOW LINE RESTRICTION

Bracken Way (Both sides from it's junction with Broad Street to 15m North thereof)

Broad street (Various lengths both sides from 26m east of its junction with Broomfield Close to the roundabout at the junction with A323 Aldershot Road)

Bowers Farm Drive (Various lengths both sides from Clay Lane Roundabout to its roundabout with Cotts Wood Drive)

London Road (Both sides of the service road outside 240-230 London Road thereof)

Regalfield Close (Both sides from its junction with Worplesdon Road to 15m West)

Shepherd's Hill Road (Both sides from it's junction with Worplesdon Road to 25m West thereof)

Worplesdon Road (Various lengths both sides from 20m North of its junction with Regalfield close to 20m South East of it's junction with New Cross Road)

Heathermount (Various lengths both sides from it's junction with Broad Street on the western arm 7 metres south-east thereof and on the eastern arm 5 metres south thereof)

INTRODUCE NO WAITING MON – FRI 8.30 – 6PM SINGLE YELLOW LINE RESTRICTIONS

Broad Street (Various lengths both sides from 13m east of it's junction with Heather Mount to 30m west of the roundabout at junction of A323 Aldershot Road)
