## GUILDFORD ON-STREET PARKING MANAGEMENT REVIEW -MADE AMENDMENTS TO THE GUILDFORD TOWN AREA OUTSIDE OF THE GUILDFORD TOWN CENTRE CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AMENDMENT ORDER (No. 2) 2021

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Surrey County Council has made an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and 36 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') the effect of which is to further amend "The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Guildford (Guildford Town Area Outside of the Guildford Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions Street Parking Places and Revocation) Order 2004". The Order, known as "The Surrey County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Guildford (Guildford Town Centre Controlled Parking County Council Various Roads in the Borough of Guildford (Guildford Town Area Outside Of The Guildford Town Centre Controlled Parking Zone) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions Street Parking Places and Revocation) Amendment Order (No.2) 2021" makes the changes as described below.

The general purpose and effect of the Order will be to:

(a) introduce new At Any Time waiting restrictions,

(b) provide that in the lengths of roads referred to in paragraph (a) above that, in respect to waiting restrictions, the usual exemptions for loading and unloading vehicles, boarding and alighting from vehicles, using vehicles for works on or adjoining those lengths of roads and the services in them and for disabled persons' vehicle in accordance with the "Blue Badge" Scheme will apply,
(c) "introduce an at any time Disabled Persons' Free Parking Place for use by any disabled person's vehicle displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge" free of charge and without time limit"
(d) in respect to paragraph (c) above, any vehicle may wait in that parking place for the purposes of boarding and alighting (for a period not exceeding two minutes), or for the purpose of loading or unloading goods (for a period not exceeding twenty minutes).

**Napier Gardens** (Various lengths both sides from its junction with Collingwood Crescent eastwards for a distance of 50 metres) **Cunningham Avenue** (Various lengths both sides from 15m North of its junction with Boxgrove Lane to 15m North East of its junction with Collingwood Crescent)

**Collingwood Crescent** (Various lengths both sides from its junction with Cunningham Avenue to 15m north of its junction with Napier Gardens)
