Event: KRY UK Ubhauri “Ascending” Festival 2026

This document provides the premises plan for the Ubhauri (Sakela / Sakewa) cultural festival organised by Kirat Rai Yayokkha UK at Kirat Rai House.

The festival is a traditional cultural celebration of the Kirat Rai indigenous community of Nepal and includes ceremonial Silli dance, cultural performances, community gatherings, and traditional food stalls. The event is a family-friendly community festival expected to attract approximately **3000–4500 attendees throughout the day**.

This premises plan consists of three sections:

Page 2 – Overall Premises Plan

Shows the wider site layout including the main event arena, car parks, traffic flow routes, vehicle entry and exit points, security control points, and emergency access routes.

Page 3 – Main Event Arena Layout

Shows the detailed layout of the main event area including the stage, Silli dance arena, Sakela ceremonial area, food and cultural stalls, licensed bar area, toilets, medical points, and other event facilities.


All entry and exit points will be managed by professional security personnel together with designated car park stewards. Visitors arriving by vehicle will be directed and assisted by stewards to ensure vehicles are parked safely and in an orderly manner.

Traffic movement within the site will be controlled to ensure safe access for attendees and to maintain clear routes for emergency vehicles at all times.

The event will also be supported by members of the Executive Committee and volunteers of Kirat Rai Yayokkha UK, many of whom are retired members of the British Gurkha Army, together with professional security staff, medical personnel, and ambulance support throughout the event.
