Page 193, Appendix C – Students, international migration and housing need in Guildford, reads:

## Accommodation Status

Figure C.9 illustrates the percentage of the 13,462 students aged over 16 living in Guildford Borough by their accommodation status based on 2011 Census data. As shown, around 26% live in all student households and 8% in shared accommodation where not all of the household are students. This equates to around 3,500 and 1,900 respectively. These household types are largely accommodated in the Private Rented Sector. According to the University of Surrey they have, 4,700 students living off Campus, some of whom will be outside the Borough.

## Accommodation Status

Figure C.9 (**Profile of Students aged 16 and over in Guildford Borough, 2011**) illustrates the percentage of the 13,462 students aged over 16 living in Guildford Borough by their accommodation status based on 2011 Census data. As shown, around 26% live in all student households and 8% in shared accommodation where not all of the household are students. This equates to around **3,450** and **1,020** respectively (**see Figure C.12**). These household types are largely accommodated in the Private Rented Sector. According to the University of Surrey they have, 4,700 students living off Campus, some of whom will be outside the Borough.
